### Position Summary:

Dream Catcher Therapy Center is seeking highly motivated and compassionate Mental Health Professionals or Clinical Interns / Counseling Candidates to provide specialized therapeutic services to meet the needs of the following client populations:

1. Autistic/Neurodiverse individuals
2. Clients impacted by Trauma
3. Children (experience/interest in Play Therapy services)

Clinicians will manage their client caseloads as independent contractors.

### Key Specialized Roles (Candidates should specify their area of interest):

#### 1. Neurodiversity Specialist

- Provide affirming and evidence-based therapy to autistic and neurodiverse clients across the lifespan.
- Focus on sensory, communication, and executive functioning challenges.

#### 2. Trauma Specialist

- Utilize trauma-informed and trauma-specific treatment modalities (e.g., EMDR, TF-CBT) for clients with acute or complex trauma.
- Support stabilization, processing, and recovery.



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### 3. Child & Play Therapy Specialist

- Provide developmentally appropriate therapeutic interventions, primarily Play Therapy, for children (ages 3-12).
- Engage parents/caregivers in collateral sessions to support the child's treatment goals.

### Benefits & Professional Development:

- Comprehensive Supervision (Available at No Cost): Robust supervision is provided for:

- Master's or Doctoral degree in a mental health field (or current enrollment in a clinical program for Interns).
- Current CO licensure (LPC, LCSW, LMFT, LP) or pre-licensure status (LPCC, MFTC, SWC).
- Demonstrated training, interest, or experience in one of the three specialty areas listed above.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills for clinical documentation.
- Ability to work independently and manage a clinical caseload.
